





- End with next steps




Language Shifts

New: “I noticed the report was submitted after the deadline. What challenges emerged?”





WHY PSYCHOLOGICAL SAFETY AND COLLABORATION MATTER

- Psychological safety creates an environment where teams confidently learn from mistakes, take accountability, and drive innovative solutions
- Collaboration amplifies our ability to respond effectively and adapt quickly during public health emergencies
- The success of public health initiatives relies on cohesive teams working seamlessly toward common goals

PHIG QUARTERLY CALLS MODEL

- Interactive quarterly virtual convenings that connect and energize our public health teams
- Diverse facilitators and spotlighted teams sharing fresh perspectives and best practices
- Real-time anonymous polling to capture honest insights and drive meaningful dialogue
- Dynamic visual dashboards that promote transparency and keep everyone informed



EVIDENCE-BASED STRATEGIES



- Model inclusive leadership behaviors
- Use structured check-ins
- Encourage perspective-taking through prompts
- Promote informal social interactions
- Facilitate multiple channels for participation
- Define clear communication protocols and roles

OUTCOMES OF PHIG CALLS

- Increased morale and participation
- Enhanced cross-program collaboration
- Improved accountability of deliverables



TOOLS TO SUPPORT IMPLEMENTATION



- Inclusive leadership: Teams (features, reactions)
- Structured check-ins: Slido polls
- Perspective-taking: Whiteboard prompts
- Informal socializing: Breakout rooms
- Multiple channels: Teams chat, audio, video
- Clear roles: Trello task tracking






